

## JUBILEE CULTURAL CEREMONY (IN HONOUR OF NGAJ MURUNGU)

Nov 20th, 21st & 22nd 2007



3 day dedication by Embu, Meru & Gikuyu Communities, with full time prayers & fasting in their homes, in comemoration of Gods covenant box put on Mt. Kenya in 1210 AD by their forefathers.

### GOD'S MOUNTAIN AND HIS PEOPLE

In the 3 days, the Mt. Kenya seers will be orienting "Managi" (God's covenant box) in a style which they call Mugwanja - Mugwanja. This calls for blessing for the whole nation 7 times and condemnation of its enemies 7 times. The mau mau who saw action in the war of independence will be performing prayers and rituals in the designated groves as promised to Ngai Murungu in their prayers of 1948. It is on this mountain God promised mau mau that the British Government would not only loose war in Kenya but would loose the whole British empire in 10 years from 1953. The rest of the 3 communities (Embu, Meru & Agikuyu) shall remain indoors in prayers and fasting. This 3 day total dedication to Ngai Murungu is observed once every 50years, to renew communities covenant with God Almighty. The present Gikuyu (3 communities) who were known as "Kabiru" (Hebrew) came from Bacil (Ethiopia) at a place called Hakum (Axum). They left Axum because Tunyaga (the people of the cross) or Nguro ndune (the red costume) wanted to steal "Managi" (God's Covenant box) and "Kunjo" (Coptic Scrolls or Primitive Torah). After 2 generations of fighting with Tunyaga they arrived at Mt. Kenya and hurriedly buried the covenant box & the scrolls in 3 secret locations in the mountain, in 1210AD. Just as King David had prophesied in Psalms 68: 31 "The Ethiopians will raise their hands in prayer to God" As a rufe they oriented their doors facing Mt. Kenya, in adittion while they were in prayes they raised their hands up facing that mountain. Read - "Facing Mt. Kenya" by Jomo Kayatta. They settled around the mountain to guard their treasure (Managi & kunjo).
